The Hope Diamond

The long, storied and sometimes questionable history of a famous blue rock.

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In honor of Winston, the diamond has been placed in a temporary commemorative setting (called Embracing Hope), which coincides with the debut of the documentary film, Mystery of the Hope Diamond.

French explorer Jean Baptiste Tavemier sells a 112-carat blue stone found in India to King Louis XIV of France.

The royal jeweler recuts the stone to create a 67-carat diamond. It's renamed

The French Blue.

Louis XVI and Mane Antoinette tum their royal jewels over to the government during the French Revolution. The French Blue later disappears.

1673

The diamond surfaces in the catalog of British banker and author Henry Thomas Hope.

Pierre Cartier buys the stone.

Famed jeweler Harry Winston buys McLean's entire diamond collection

after her death

2010

Evelyn Walsh McLean of Washington, D.C. buys the diamond from Cartier for \$180,000 She has it set in a pendant necklace

Beautiful, blue-eyed actress Michelle Pfeiffer is photographed wearing the diamond for Life magazine.

Winston donates the diamond, now 4552 carats and known as the Hope Diamond to the Smith sonian Institution.



The Hope Diamond was the inspiration for the Gern of the Ocean, the centerpiece of 1997's Titanic
